- Review of potential framework: *Mapping Moving Trains*. The workgroup is considering how this framework may be adapted to provide a quick summary of the family leadership opportunities. One consideration is to place the categories of family leadership characteristics (developed by this team) as the rows of the document and the family leadership opportunities as the columns of the document.
- Consideration of sending electronic survey to organizations.
 - Goal to capture existing Family Leadership Opportunities using the circular framework shared by Eileen Forlenza (family ring, community ring, and others [system] ring). The workgroup determined it will be important to define and provide examples of family leadership opportunities of each ring

Updates to the draft survey will be made based on feedback from this meeting. During the next workgroup meeting on 10/8/2015, we will continue to explore components to include in the survey.
Elements to include:
 - Culturally Specific information (is the resource available in different languages).
 - Including an area to add the website/link to online information about leadership opportunity.
 - Skill area outcomes (with provided list of examples)
 - Incorporating examples and definitions throughout the survey
 - Discussion TBC on 10/8/2015
 - Timeline Goals: design/update survey tool October 2015, test survey tool in November, distribute survey beginning in January 2016.
- Vision Planning
 - Workgroup considered outcomes of capturing family leadership resources identified through mapping activity.
 - Organizations willing to host, reference, link to developed Family Leadership resource database. Family Voices of Wisconsin has a current list of some of the known family leadership opportunities on their website. Family Voices is willing to host information family leadership opportunities identified through distribution of the survey. DPI will willing to explore how opportunities may be incorporated into the WSPEI calendar. Other programs willing to link to the organization page where the resource is housed.
