We have developed a Maternal Child Health Coalition whose objective is to promote consistent developmental screening in children from age 0-5 in Sheboygan County. This also ensures children are properly referred, if needed, and parents are properly educated regarding the screening results and activities they may do with their child to encourage age-appropriate development.

The American Academy of Pediatrics recommends regular, universal developmental screening of infants and young children by primary pediatric healthcare providers at 9, 18, 24 and 30 months of age, using standardized screening tools....to identify children in need of further assessment and diagnosis, and appropriate referral for early intervention and educational services as indicated.
