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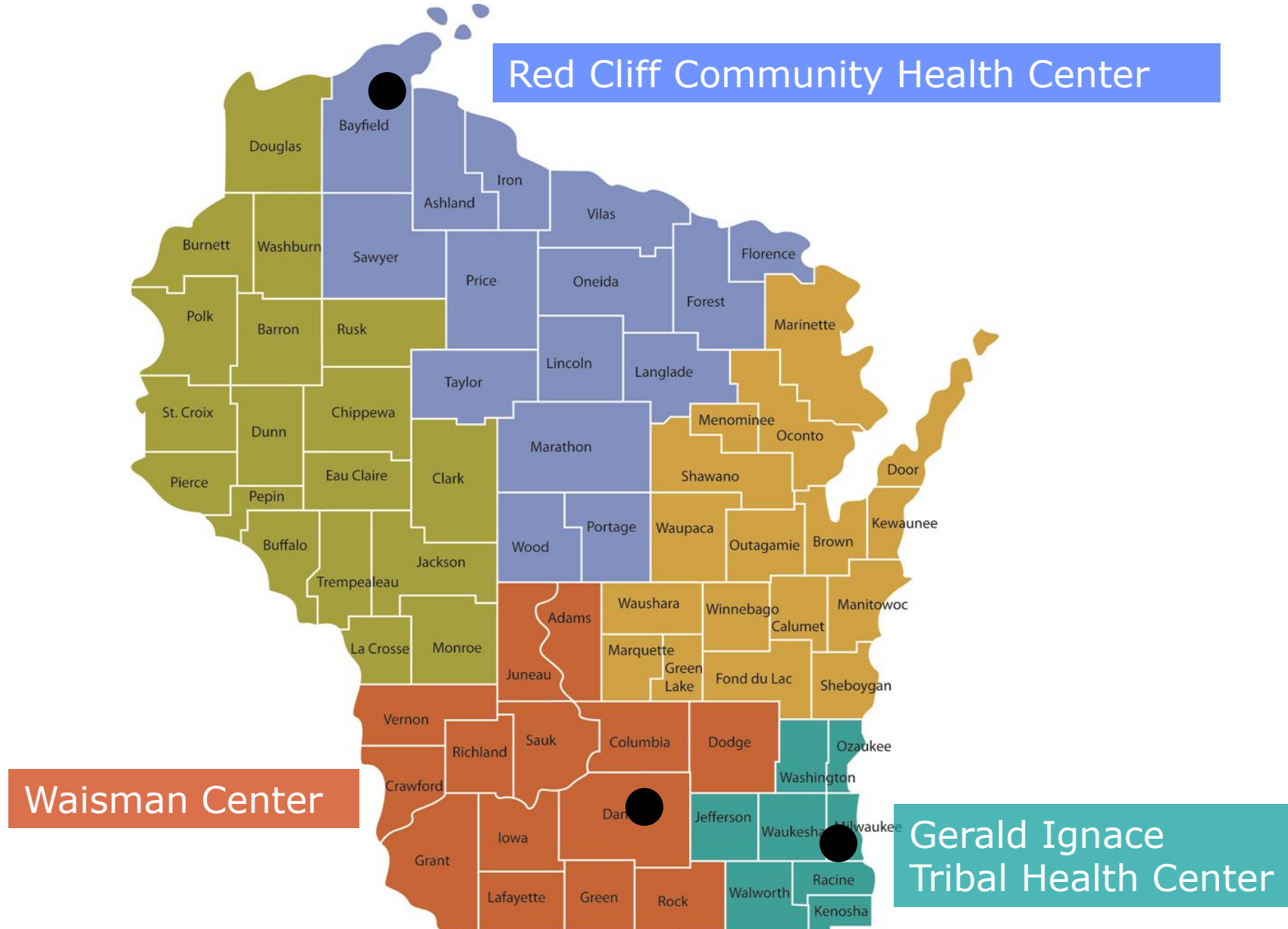

Strengthening Communication with EI

The goal of this focus area is to strengthen communication between medical homes and Birth to 3 (Wisconsin's EI program) to enhance care for children with delays.

Expectations:

- Track outcomes of referrals made to the Birth to 3 Program with at least **five** children in your practice.
- Report on feedback from the Birth to 3 Program if the referral was received.

Strengthening Communication with EI

An option to facilitate such communication is the Department of Health Services' (DHS) approved form **Referral to Wisconsin Birth to 3 Program (F-00688)**. This HIPAA- and FERPA-compliant form is designed to facilitate referral from clinicians to a Birth to 3 Program.

Parent consent allows joint release of information between clinicians and the Birth to 3 Program.
